Shooting	As rule 408 AGB Rules of Shooting (Apr 26). All compound archers are to shoot on a 5-spot Worcester face. Other bow styles may request the 5 spot face NO LATER than 8 th October,
Individual Awards	Trophies and/or medals will be awarded for the Double Round in the divisions of: Recurve, Compound, Barebow & Longbow. Archer categories will be: Open and Female in each Senior, Junior and +50.
Garrington Cup	The make up of teams will be selected by the TO based on highest scoring archers in the required categories.
Refreshments	Hot and cold drinks will be available as well as a selection of cakes and pastries
Photography	In the view of provisions of the Archery GB Protection of Children and Vulnerable Adults Policy, those who wish to take photographs at this event are required to register on arrival with the Tournament Organiser.
Dress Code	Archery GB dress regulations will apply (rule 307) and will be enforced.
